Merry Christmas to all! It is hard to believe another year has flown by. We are so very thankful to all who faithfully pray for us and support us financially.

We will have our first Christmas banquet on December 23rd for our church family. We have many people who attend faithfully, but some of their family members are missing. We are using our Christmas banquet as a way to reach out to those family members to get them with the rest of their family where they belong. Please pray with us that those who said they would attend actually do and that the Holy Spirit touches their hearts and they see their need of salvation.

The first Sunday in December marked the first service of the beginning of a new church in Can-Aga, Sibonga, Cebu. This place is up in the mountains and is very difficult to get to. It is the place where Gina is from and her parents allowed us to build a small chapel on their property to hold services. Pastor Johnny Lim, who has a church nearby, is conducting the services. When it is raining, which it has been doing a lot of, he gets there by horse. We thank God for an attendance of 15 the first week and 13 the second week. Please pray for this baby work in a place where the Gospel has never been proclaimed.

We are also diligently preparing for the arrival of our pastor and 32 other members of our church in February to conduct a Sword of the Lord Conference. Pastor Norris will be preaching and the Soul Winning Directors College will be taught to local pastors. The rest of the group will be teaching in local public and private schools for the ten days they will be here. We are very excited to see some familiar faces and to see the Lord use this group. The conference dates are February 21-24, 2011. Please pray that we would see a great revival from God.

Last prayer letter I asked you to pray about a piece of property we had found. The Lord shut the door to that piece of land. But as always, He has better plans! I received a phone call from a lady who now lives in New York, but is originally from Carcar. She wants to make sure she has a church to go to when she comes back from America, so she is donating a piece of land to the church! We have been praying specifically, as a church, for God to give us land and He has answered that prayer! The process of donating the land will take a little time, but the process is already underway.

Please also pray for our young man Chris. I have asked you to pray for him in the past and ask you to continue to do so. He has been doing more and more at the church and he has shown himself to be very faithful. I am not sure yet exactly how the Lord will use him, but I know He will. Please pray for his spiritual development and training.

Back in September we received word that one of our assistant pastors, Pastor Larry Staner passed away very unexpectedly. Pastor Staner led Gina to Christ and had a profound impact on our lives. He will be sorely missed, but we look forward even more to that glad reunion we will have one day.
