Dear Fellow Laborers,

Greetings in the name of our wonderful Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ! God is so very good and we are so thankful for His provision and protection each and every day! We can say with the Psalmist "For the LORD is good; his mercy is everlasting; and his truth endureth to all generations." Psalm 100:5

We have been working hard at the ministry and are thankful for the fruit the Lord allows us to have. One thing that has been keeping us busy is delivering relief goods to several of our missionaries who were affected by the typhoon. There is much more detail about this on our website if you are interested. We have seen the Lord save hundreds of souls as a result of this disaster. We are probably finished, or possibly have one more trip before completeing our efforts. Please pray for safety and protection and wisdom in this endeavor.

As you may know there was a significant earthquake here in Cebu while we were back in the States. It affected our church building with some minor damage. The owner of the building was very generous in making repairs and making sure the building is safe for use. One thing that happened, which we did not learn until we got back from the States, is that a piece of concrete fell off the building and hit our electric piano. The piece of concrete broke several keys on the piano - all of them right in the middle - keys that are used the most frequently. If we were aware of the damage before we left the States we could have bought a replacement piano in America and brought it back with us. To purchase the same exact piano, same model even, is twice as expensive here as it is in America because of taxes and duty, etc. Many of our young people have been learning the piano, but they have stopped becuae their fingers hurt from hitting keys that are broken. When Nathan plays he transposes the song from the original key to Db or Ab and then uses the transpose function on the keyboard to put it back to the original key, that keeps him from having to use the broken white keys. I am so thankful he has the ability to do that, but many of our young people do not. We are praying for funds for a new digital piano that could replace the one broken in the earthquake.

In January Pastor Daniel who has been working with us for just over two years now, informed me he would like to take a break from the ministry for a while. This has left a huge void in our ministry and we would appreciate your prayers for him as he seeks God's will in his life. Also please pray that God would send us someone else who might help labor with us here. Chris De La Torre remains faithful and continues to be a great help and blessing. He still needs much training though.

While I know many of you are experiencing some very cold weather there in America, we are making preparations for summer break here. We already have invitations to two camps, and have begun to make preparations for our Vacation Bible Time and our missions trip for our teens. Summers are busy so please keep us in your prayers at this time.

Gina and the kids are doing well and we are all so thankful for your prayers and concern for us all. We are truly blessed to have such wonderful partners in the ministry. For the Faith,
