Dear Fellow Laborers,

Greetings from the Philippines! It is so hard to believe that it is the last day of September already! Where has the time gone? Truly our life is but a vapor.

At the beginning of the month we were privileged to have a revival service with Bro Harrell Noble, his wife Jeannie and Pastor Richard Smith. The only time available was Wednesday evening until Friday evening, which is an unusual time to have services. We were blessed to have our people come and several local churches, as well as several visitors. We had two saved during the services and then one of our members led her neighbor, who she brought to the service, to Christ after they got home. The preaching during the revival really stirred our hearts and since then we have seen many more people come to Christ. The fellowship that we enjoyed with Bro Harrell and his wife and Pastor Smith was precious.

The first day of the revival we learned that one of the sisters of a church member recently had a heart attack. She had been in the hospital for a week and had just gotten home and it was the first we had heard of it. We went to visit this lady at her home. She had been witnessed to many times before, but was always hard hearted toward the Gospel. I had the privilege of leading this lady down the Romans road and to a saving knowledge of Christ. She was in great pain, and had difficulty speaking, but prayed out loud to call on the Lord Jesus Christ as her Savior! The next day we visited and took her a Bible. At one point we wanted to show her a verse and she would not allow us to take the Bible from her to show her, she refused to let go of it! The next morning, this lady went to be with her Savior. We were able to preach the funeral and many came to the Lord as a result. We are so grateful that we were able to be there to share the Gospel with her.

We are still not sure about the land. Much paperwork needs to be done and the owners are moving very slowly to do it. We are not concerned - the Lord kept the Promised Land for Israel for over 400 years - He will have the exact right place for us when the time is ready.

We are praying about starting a new church in the next town down from us, Sibonga. We may already have a meeting place, it just needs a little work to fix it up. Sibonga is the town where we teach the police each week and several of our members are from there as well. Pray that the Lord would open doors for us to be able to begin to minister there.

We are also working on things for next year. We are planning on giving each of our members a 2016 calendar at Christmas time with a Bible reading schedule on it. We are going to encourage our people to spend more time in the Word of God. Please pray that this simple calendar will be an effective reminder to them.

We are also planning an activity for our children at the end of October during their semester break. We are focusing on "God is Light" during this time. Please pray that our kids would learn the importance of a right relationship with the Lord before their death. This is just prior to all-saints and all-souls day where many will spend all night in cemeteries with their dead relatives.

We have been battling sickness in the family for a few weeks now so please continue to pray for our health. Again we thank you for your love and support for us.
